The Pan African Climate Justice Alliance (PACJA) is a continental coalition of civil society organizations in the African continent, brought together by common goal of promoting and advocating for climate-friendly and equity-based development. Drawing its membership from Non-governmental organizations, Foundations, Trusts, Community-based organizations, faith-based networks, national coalitions and regional networks from 45 countries in Africa; PACJA aims to unify isolated civil society efforts on climate change advocacy and coordination in Africa, so as to ensure that pro-poor and people-centred response measures are put into consideration as governments in Africa seek to mainstream climate change into national development strategies.

In the pursuit of its mandate, PACJA collaborates and encourages strategic alliances with international partners, national governments, regional governmental bodies as well as individuals sharing its aspirations, to ensure that the African voice is amplified in international climate change dialogue processes. The Alliance works with like-minded partners from the North and the South, so as to ensure that the resultant framework agreed by the community of nations after the conclusion of the ongoing, yet acrimonious international climate change dialogue process is not only equitable, but also a product of massive consultation, responsive to the realities of vulnerable communities.
